# MEMBER SPOTLIGHT

## Andrew Raddie 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice Commander

#### Master Sergeant Raddie

Andy served in the U.S. Air Force from 1948–1972<sup>1</sup>. He was a flight mechanic who worked on C46's, C47's, C19's, C82's, and C118's. He was stationed at the U.S. Embassy in Germany and Spain. He crewed for the ambassadors. When asked if the ambassadors where down-to-earth people, he replied yes without hesistation. Now, the ambassadors' wives...another story.

In the 18 months Andy spent in Viet Nam (1968-1969), he worked classified missions in Pleiku conducting surveillance along the Ho Chi Minh Trail. They intercepted Viet Cong communications as they travelled down the trail. Andy received the Distinguished Flying Cross.

From 1968 to 27 June 1972 the 362d Tactical Electronic Warfare Squadron flying specially-equipped EC-47s were assigned to Pleiku. These aircraft were equipped with various electronic warfare components. The 633rd Special Operations Wing was activated at Pleiku

on 15 July 1968. Its mission was to provide close air support, day and night interdiction, and visual and photo reconnaissance.

#### After the Military

Andy retired from Andrews Air Force Base where he crewed for a 2-star General. From there, he took his mechanic skills to the trucking industry where he became the Chief Mechanic for Smelkinson Trucking and later, Fleet Manager for Waste Management. He kept our skies safe and then our roadways.

#### Husband and Dad

After 23 years of marriage, Andy lost his first wife. Then after 36 years of marriage, he lost his second wife to cancer. But, his legacy continues to serve. Andy has two sons (one, the SAL Commander of a Post in WV) and a daughter (Beth, our Auxiliary President at Post 7). To the Raddie family: THANK YOU!!!!!


